Dear Shipmates and Friends,

We had a very successful reunion in San Antonio, Texas last September. In our men's meeting, I opened a letter from Chuck Kelley. He is one of our few remaining World War II veterans (1945-47). Chuck made a very generous (and I mean VERY GENEROUS) gift to our reunion group. We are putting half of it towards a plaque in honor of the Blue at the World War II Museum in Fredericksburg, Texas. The other half was donated to the "Quilts of Honor", a volunteer non-profit group led by Gail Belmont. These volunteers, including Rita Padilla, many of her friends and several from our Ladies group, made a quilt for every crewmember who attended the reunion. Each one was individualized with our names on them. There were many tears that night. If you would like to make a donation to this great group, I will add their address at the end. This year's reunion will be in Charleston, South Carolina. The dates are September 22nd – 25th, 2016. The hotel that will be hosting us is the Radisson Hotel Charleston Airport.
